Dear Parents and Students,

Greetings!

In the event of the Board Examination 2021 being cancelled for Class X, the results of Class X will be prepared on the basis of an objective criterion to be developed by the Board, which we are yet to receive. There is a possibility of the Board asking the schools to consider the class IX performance of students. However, we are waiting for guidelines from the CBSE for the same.

You are familiar with the internal assessment structure that was followed during the AY 2020-21. We are sharing the same for your reference.

Pen Paper Test and Multiple Assessment (5+5)	10 Marks
Portfolio	05 Marks
Lab Practical (Lab activities)	05 Marks

The Pen Paper Tests were the three periodic tests that had been conducted during the months July-August, October and December 2020. The July-August and December tests were administered online using google forms. The mid-term test, comprising both objective and subjective items, in the month of October was again online using both google form and google classroom.

Portfolio activities were posted in the google classroom, which all the students were a part of, created for academic transactions, and the students were asked to submit the scanned copies of the activities on the mentioned dates. This was an ongoing activity commencing from March 2020 to February 2021.

Lab activities in the subjects Mathematics, Science and AI/IT were conducted during the online sessions either through demonstration or simulations. Students were asked to perform the activities and submit the recording and written work in the template provided and upload in the google classroom. The experiments were again conducted physically when students reported to school for offline sessions.

In Languages, activities to test their speaking and listening skills were ongoing during the regular sessions. In Social Science, students were given project work as a part of internal assessment.

Apart from these, students were also to submit an art integrated project based on the paired state of Uttarakhand.

While most of the students have done the activities and assignments, and uploaded them in the google classroom, there are a few students who are yet

to complete these tasks, in spite of frequent reminders from teachers. As you know, there are students who have not taken the periodic tests earnestly and hence have performed unsatisfactorily.

For those students who have consistently scored unsatisfactory grades, we may consider giving another opportunity for writing an examination. Such students need to prepare for the same. In case the students are unwilling to appear for a re-examination their previous scores will be sent to the Board.

### **What needs to be done now?**

- We are sharing excel sheets, subject wise, with the details of submission of assignments and projects. We request you to complete all the pending work and submit the work by 28<sup>th</sup> April 2021 without fail.
- The excel sheet / check list is for submitting the physical / hard copy of the activities. Though most of you have submitted in the google classroom, we would now require all of you to submit the same in hard copy. If you have misplaced the original document, you may take the print from the google classroom and submit. Let your work be neat, organised and relevant as this will be considered for your assessment.
- We would require all evidences; assignments and projects to be submitted in hard copy at the school on or before 28<sup>th</sup> April 2021.
- Those who have not submitted the answer papers of preparatory examinations, to bring them to school and submit it to the respective class teacher. We will require these papers as evidences for the internal assessment.
- Submission of portfolios and answer papers may be done personally or sent through courier to the school address.
- Those who are yet to pay the Annual Fees/Transport Fees SHOULD pay it before the end of this month, for the school to complete the other formalities.
