Junior Sports Day

Though most of the school year is about academics, Sports Days are very important also. The Junior Sports Day was held on Nov 22, 2019. It was inaugurated by releasing pigeons. The students involved were those from Pre-Primary to Class 2. Ms. Kushi H, a renowned international yoga champion, was the Chief Guest of the day. Pre-primary children displayed drill followed by a dance by 148 students. Class 1 children (137 students) exhibited a dance. Class 2 (148 students) displayed a hoop and dumbbell dance. A total of 36 individual and 36 group events were conducted.

STEM Fest 2019

The STEM initiative is meant to encourage children to explore their interests in Science and Math with real world applications. To this end, the annual STEM fest was held for students from classes 5 to 12 on 30th Nov, 2019. This festival exemplified the truth that all technological developments depend on discoveries made in pure science, and lived upto its creed of honing the multiple intelligences of students.

Dr. K S M S Raghavarao, Director, CFTRI, Mysuru, inaugurated the fest and delivered the keynote address. The fest had primarily two facets: Mendeleev's Tapestry and Bits, Bytes & Brains. EPS joined the global initiative of UNESCO's declaration of year 2019 as the International Year of Periodic Table. The program "Musical Spallation of the Elements" showcased songs on noble gases and Kolar gold fields, a mime on endangered elements, a political melodrama on rare earth elements and a fashion show on elemental siblings. The labs and clubs showcased various models related to the most happening topics in their respective domains. Class 5 and 6 students showcased projects that involved extensive Arduino programming.



In a nutshell, the fest helped students to go beyond their textbooks and hone their collaboration skills across classes and teams.

Social Outreach Program – Term II

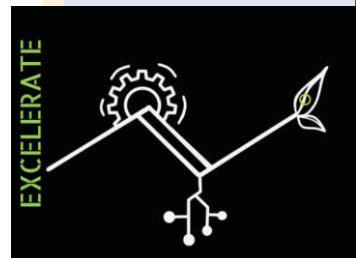
Quizzing to Keep Current

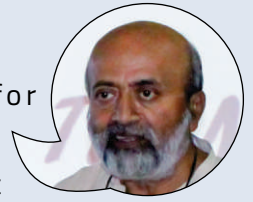
Creating CALM Classrooms

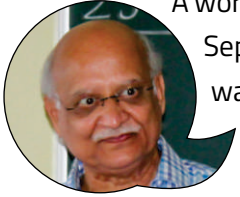
Innovative Math Workshop

A visit to horse stable

Sat Sri Akaal!

Educational tours are an excellent means of understanding aspects of our history and culture. The 2019 tour from the Excel Public School exposed the children to the vibrant and loud culture of the northwest frontier of the country while

traversing the two states of Haryana and Punjab. As part of the educational trip for 2019, about 74 students from class 10 accompanied by 8 teachers went on a four-day trip to Punjab from Nov 16 th to 20th. They visited Chandigarh, Amritsar, and the Attari-Wagah border. They saw historic places like Jallianwala Bagh, the Maharajah Ranjit Singh Museum and the War Memorial, as well as the famous Nek Chand Rock Garden of Chandigarh. They came back to Mysore enriched by their visit to a whole different perspective of their own motherland.

Exposure to Fine Art

Sri Jayachamarajendra Art Gallery Trust housed in Jaganmohan Palace is one of the best art galleries in South India. Once a royal residence, Jaganmohan Palace Art Gallery houses the maximum number of art works of Raja Ravi Varma. Another famous painting is the 'Glow of Hope' by S L Haldankar. The Mural room on the second floor of the Art Gallery and the French Musical Calendar Clock are also renowned for their unique beauty. The children of Class 5 enjoyed the outing especially as one of the guards there pointed out some amazing aspects of the paintings.

Understanding Tribal Culture

Students of class 7 were taken to Anthropological Survey of India, Mysuru division, on 13 Dec, 2019, as an extended learning activity for the lesson 'Tribes, Nomads and Settled Communities'. The students gathered the information on various tribal communities living in India. They also observed the collection of artifacts on tribal life style, habitat, dressing styles and occupations. This visit enhanced their knowledge on the unique societies of tribes from different parts of the country and enhanced their curiosity about them. They also watched documentaries on tribal communities at the end. Another outcome of the field trip was that the students were able to appreciate the work of anthropological department in preserving the rich sources of Indian ethnicity.
