LEARNING STATIONS

A change in the setting breaks the monotony and helps to learn concepts, opening up a learners' mind for meaningful learning. Children learn at their pace while teachers act as facilitators. They learn to work independently, which gives the child more control over what to do. Learning stations build creativity, responsibility, and decision-making skills.

Creative Corner

Children explore different art methods using clay, paints, crayons, and other craft materials available in nature helping students to think outside the box and flourish.

Language Corner

Literacy skill is the most important skill that builds confidence in children and helps in their academic performance. Our language corner has hands-on resources and materials that lay a strong foundation to develop listening, speaking, writing, reading and comprehension skills.

Curiosity Corner

This unique learning centre aims to stimulate learners' curiosity to explore and experiment solutions to their queries. It helps build awareness around them and connect to abstract concepts on various themes and facts.





Math Lab

Children explore various concrete materials to comprehend math concepts. They learn to compare, sort, classify and differentiate various attributes. They develop number sense, estimation, patterns, measurement and basic operational skills.



Reading Zone

Doll House

Indoor activities are great for developing fine motor skills. While learning becomes fun, indoor games encourage young learners to explore new ideas and concepts.

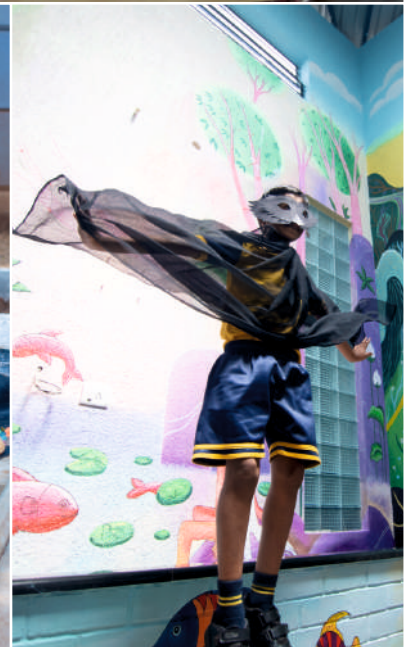


Outdoor Activities
