General Instructions:

Format:

The CCA competitions will be conducted at 2 stages-

Stage 1: Intra-house

Stage 2: Inter-house

Stage 1

- Students will register for the events through the Google form, the link for which is shared at the end of this circular.
- A student can participate in a maximum of 3 literary and 3 cultural events (either group or individual).
- Each house, under the guidance of the Mentors and the Captains and Vice-Captains, will conduct the events at the house level to select students who will represent the house for Stage 2. [5 students in the case of individual events and 2 groups in the case of group events.]
- The schedule (Date, Time and Venue) for conducting the events at Stage 1 will be prepared by the respective Head Teachers in consultation with the Vice-Principal.
- The CCA committee for each section will be responsible for preparing the rubrics for judgement and collating the score sheets after the competition.
- The list of students shortlisted will be submitted to the Head Teachers of the respective sections by the CCA committee.

Stage 2

- The finals of all the events will culminate in a Cultural Fest on specified days for each section.
- The 5 students selected from Stage 1 to represent their house will participate in the finals at Stage 2. Similarly, 2 groups selected will participate in the finals at Stage 2.
- The judges for the competitions will be decided by the CCA committee and the Head Teachers in consultation with the Vice-Principal.
- The decision of the judges will be final and abiding.

Scoring

- In the case of individual events, the points for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd positions respectively are 5, 3, and 1.
- In the group events, the winners and runners will be awarded 10 and 5 points respectively.

Literary & Cultural Championship

- One Girl and One Boy from each section will be considered for the championship award based on the total points secured in individual events.
- All individual events, both literary and cultural, will be considered to calculate the scores for the individual championship award.
- A candidate must have won at least one prize in both the literary and cultural events to be eligible for selection.
- The score in the group events will not be considered.
