

Excel Public School Students Reach Finals of Global Innovation Challenge 2024

Three student-led projects -AGRIFEED PRO, AI ROADCARE, and RATIONEASE from Excel Public School are among the top finalists in the prestigious 2024 Global Innovation Challenge, a programme supporting community organisations that develop innovative solutions to social and economic challenges.

The top finalists, Nandan Hegde and Aryan Kini from Grade 10 and Bhuvan PM from Grade 11 advanced their project 'AGRIFEED PRO'. The project 'AI ROAD CARE' was developed by Tanish Tejaswi M S, Bhuvan PM, and Namasyu A, all from Grade 11. Ananthanarayan Pranav, Nandan Hegde, and Leysha Prashant from Grade 10 developed their product 'RATIONEASE'.

All three nominated projects, aided by science and technology, address critical societal needs.

In receiving this recognition, the students of Excel Public School have demonstrated their adherence to creativity and ingenuity.

The seven finalists will present their innovative projects at the Global Innovation Field Trip (GIFT), a prestigious international platform, on October 14 and 15, where they will compete alongside participants from 26 countries.
