ANNUAL REPORT TO BE PRESENTED ON THE OCCASION OF 11TH ANNUAL DAY (10th February 2020)

Our Sixth batch of Class 10 and First batch of Class XII students came out in flying colours with 100% result in the CBSE Examination. Out of the 15 students appeared in Class XII, six of them secured above 90%, with two of them securing 94.6%. Out of the 85 students who appeared for Class 10, 28 of them secured above 90%, with the highest score being 96.6%.

We also had students securing 100% in subjects like English, Mathematics and Social Science.

I congratulate everyone for their success. In a couple weeks, our **Seventh Batch of Class X**, **108 students and Second Batch of Class XII, 22 students** will be appearing for the CBSE Board Examinations. I take this opportunity to wish all my students to do their very best in this examination.

I am also happy announce that we have decided to increase the number of optional subjects for the Senior Secondary, by adding THREE vocational subjects, Design, Applied Mathematics and Information Technology, from the academic year 2020-21.

International Recognition:

Sirius Russia:

Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog, Government of India had partnered with the Sirius Center, Russia, to provide opportunity to the students from Top 100 teams of ATL Marathon 2018-19. **Master Noel Mathew, student of Class9** was one among the 25 students

who represented India at Sochi, Russia to attend a week-long learning on Deep Technology.

Cornell University, USA

Post qualifying for the debate competition at <u>Vivekananda Institute of Indian Studies</u>, **Ms Mrudula Hamsini of Class 10**, was chosen to participate in a week long, all expense paid,
International Debate Camp held at Cornell University, USA.

New York Academy of Science

Master Karan K raj has been invited to attend the Global STEM Alliance Summit to be held in New York City, by the New York Academy of Sciences, in Summer 2020. He is one among the 900 students from 64 countries and his area of exploration is Space Colonization, centered around sustainable habitat on moon to support life. There are THREE Students from Mysore who are selected to attend this event, of which two students are alumini of EPS.

Karan K Raj has also received a recommendation from the New York Academy of Sciences to attend a three-week STEM Boot-camp from New York University and a pre-collegiate programme at the Stanford University. I wish him all the best for his success in both the programmes.

This year we had a record breaking entry of 24 Excellites into the fifth Cohort of The Junior Academy, an initiative of the New York Academy of Sciences, Global STEM Alliance (GSA). They were among the 10% of the applications across 112 countries shortlisted by the Academy and will be designing innovative solutions to global challenges.

In recognition to this, EPS received a special invite to become a Member School, which gives us the advantage of empowering teachers to become STEM advocates, and gain special access to curricular resources and STEM mentoring programs for both our students and teachers. It is certainly a great honor and a rare distinction for Excel Public School.

NASA

Master Karan K raj is also one of the top performers in the online exam conducted by Go4Guru. He has been invited to take part in the International Space Science Olympiad at Kennedy Space Centre, NASA in May 2020.

National Recognition:

In the Atal Innovation Marathon 2018 organized by the Niti Ayog, govt. of india, for its 5400 plus Atal Tinkering Labs, Excel Public School had a record breaking win of 5 projects being selected from one school to the top 200 innovations, of which the project "Power Flower" was shortlisted to the top 100 innovations. The team comprising Noel Mathew, Nikhil Mahesh Kumar and Vinyas Chandrashekhar devised an improved version of Vertical Axis Wind Turbine that can efficiently harness clean energy. They also attended a boot camp at Jyothi Institute of Technology, Bangalore.

I am glad to say that this year too we have 11 projects by our students entering in to the THIRD phase of Innovation Marathon 2019.

The ATL at Excel Public School was awarded the ATL School of the Month recognition TWICE during the current academic year, in May and August 2019. This recognition is given to TOP 30 Tinkering Labs from across the nation out of the 5400 plus ATLs.

Brainfeed School Excellence Awards 2019

EPS was awarded the School Excellence Award 2019 and top 500 schools of India in the categories of Best CBSE schools, Infrastructure schools, Techno Smart Schools, Excellence in Life Skill Education, Happiness Quotient Index Schools, for enriching the standards in imparting excellence in education to the GenNext Learners.

India International Science Festival (IISF)

18 students and 2 teachers from EPS were invited to attend India International Science Festival, at the Biswa Bangala Convention Centre Kolatta between 5th and 8th November, organized by the Ministry of Science and Technology, and Ministry of Earth Sciences and Vijnana Bharati (VIBHA), Govt. of India. The intent of this program was to engage the public with science, and show the ways how science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) provide us with the solutions to improve our lives.

The Green School Certificate

The Centre for Science and Environment (CSE) has audited the quality of school's resources such as Air, energy, food, land, water and waste and ranked EPS first in Karnataka and 23rd at the national level. 1704 schools across India participated in the green school audit programme this year. Collaborative effort of the students and the gardeners yielded this result.

Testimony to it is that EPS bagged the **first place in the decorative garden category** for the **fifth consecutive year**, at the Annual Dasara Fruit and Flower Show 2019 organized by the horticulture department.

State Recognition

Prayoga Science Cascade 2.0 Competition

6 teams from EPS comprising 23 students were shortlisted for the **Prayoga Science Cascade**2.0 Competition, a state-level contraption festival, held at Bangalore and EPS won the first and second prize in the Mt. Everest Category and second Prize in the Kanchenjunga category.

Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan 2019

Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) is a national program for educating and popularizing science among school students of grade 6 to 11. It is organized by Vijnanan Bharati, Vigyan Prasar and NCERT. Online exams were conducted at different schools across 27 states in India. Four students from EPS were shortlisted for the state camp. **Master Rohith Suresh** of class 8 has been selected for the National Camp that will be held in Chandigarh in May 2020.

STING "Innovative School of the Year Award"

Excel Public School was declared the 'Innovative School of the Year Award' at the state level science and technology fest "STING 2020" jointly organized by Karnataka Science and Technology Academy (KSTA), Department of Science and Technology, Government of Karnataka in collaboration with Eggheads Education. Students presented their ideas on "Green Earth" and won the first and second prize along with the recognition of "Innovative School"

Excellence in Teaching

As on today, EPS is a strong force of 103 teaching faculty, 14 administrative staff and 86 ancillary staff and the student strength being 1608, as on today. All our Teachers have undergone 18 days of in-house Professional Development Programme since May 2019. In addition to this 40 teachers have attended workshops, seminars and training programmes organized by various agencies, organizations and service providers, conducted both in Mysore and at other places.

50 of our staff have undergone 2 days of Fire safety and safe evacuation training organized at our school by the State Fire Department.

50 teachers are currently enrolled in Post graduate diploma programme in Counseling and Guidance through the Institute of Counselor Training, Research and Consultancy, New Delhi.

In addition to this, 37 teachers have successfully completed the Central Teacher Eligibility Test.

Ms. Gowri Ramesh, Social Science teacher and Ms Prathima, co-ordinator, were winners at the 2-day Guru Manthan 2019 state-level contest organized by Swami Vivekananda Youth Movement, which was a unique initiative to transform teaching-learning methodology and make teaching more creative.

In another event, **Ms Maria Ashwini and Ms Divya Shetty** were ranked among the top five **Master Thought Provokers** in a national level contest held for school teachers by Opendoor Education.

Ms Amita Saxena has received the Rajasthan Gourav Ratan Award in the category of contributions in the field of Education especially for under-privileged high school children. She also received Saraeswat Sanmman for her book "Man Bhavan Kahaniya". She has also successfully completed her Doctorate in Hindi Literature.

School and Community

A helping hand
