The Academic Year 2022–23 is drawing towards its close. The journey of Excel Public School over the past 14 years is a journey in pursuit of excellence, integrating classroom learning with experiential and extended learning opportunities. In this process, we have nurtured several thought leaders in the making. We have innovated and strengthened our programmes and practices, to keep pace with the needs of the 'Knowledge Economy' that we live in today. Recognised for its diverse and vibrant campus life, Excel Public School takes teaching-learning beyond classrooms, and this has contributed to the overall development of our student community. We aim to achieve the highest levels of distinction in the academic sphere, enabling students to have an enriching learning experience and empowering them to live a successful and fulfilling life.

As an institution, we envision the transformation of students into ethical, empathetic and responsible young adults. Our visionary endeavour is to empower young minds towards a progressive and humane society. By providing students with a safe and conducive environment, equipped with state-of-art facilities, we wish to be the forerunners of holistic education of students in its true sense.

With a deep sense of gratitude to all those who stood by our side during these fourteen wonderful years, let me present before this enlightened gathering a brief report of the year 2022-23.

Currently we have 2300 students from Playschool to Class 12 on roll, both Excel Foundation School and Excel Public School put together. The strength of the staff stands at 312, which include 139 teaching, 23 administrative and 150 ancillary staff.

ACADEMIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS



145 students of the 10th batch of our Class 10, and 61 students of the 5th batch of Class 12, are going to appear for their Board Exam in a couple of weeks from now. I take this opportunity to wish them all the best in their forthcoming examinations and life thereafter. I wish and pray that these students live by all the values and principles that the school has inculcated in them.

The CBSE results of our 9th batch of Class 10 and 4th batch of Class 12 have been a matter of great pride and accomplishment for our students and teachers. Divija Arjun was the topper in Class 10,

securing 98.2% and Manas Kudlapur Rakesh was the topper in Class 12, securing 97.8%. I congratulate both these students, their parents and all the teachers who mentored and guided them for this remarkable achievement. We also had 7 students securing centum, and 8 students securing 99 out of 100 in various subjects, at Class 10. In Class 12, there was 1 student securing centum in Biology and 4 students securing 99 out of 100 in other subjects. We, with great pride, commend the batch of 2021–22 for their impressive performance in the CBSE examinations.





The EPS family also lauds Manas Kudlapur Rakesh for his outstanding performance with an All India Rank of 226 in the NEET and securing a merit seat at the prestigious JIPMER, Pondicherry. Ankit Aneesh, scored an All India Rank of 83 in the CLAT Examination and procured a seat in the prestigious NLSU, Bangalore. Siddharth D secured an All India Rank 98 at the CLAT for the 2023 batch.







PROFESSIONAL ENRICHMENT PROGRAMME







The new academic year began, just like every other year, with a two-week long training programme for the existing and newly recruited teachers. Empowering our teachers to equip themselves with the necessary skills and competencies, to impart the right kind of education, in the right manner, has always been a top priority at our school. The training was followed by diverse interventions and follow-up programmes at regular intervals. I must appreciate our teaching faculty for their constant efforts to learn and grow from these programmes and for keeping themselves abreast with the recent approaches to teaching and learning. Our teachers have also been attending seminars and workshops of educational relevance held outside the school at regular intervals, both virtually and physically.

I am also happy and proud to say that 27 teachers of Excel Public School have recently completed a year-long Post Graduate Diploma in Guidance and Counselling, conducted by the Institute of Counsellor Training Research and Consultancy, New Delhi. With this, I am confident that our teachers will meet the emotional and behavioural needs of our learners while also supporting their academic growth.



Excel Public School has achieved another milestone, by establishing an exclusive Foundational School campus, in adherence to the New Education Policy

adherence to the New Education Policy (NEP 2020) at our Hootagalli campus. Here, we have 698 students, from Pre-School to Class 2, 38 teachers and 54 non-teaching staff. I thank our Management for envisioning this new initiative and creating a unique campus for the holistic development and growth of our young learners.



ACCOLADES & HONOURS



During the current academic year Excel Public School has been accorded the status of Registered Space Tutor of ISRO. The 'Space Tutor' programme aims at promoting space education by ensuring the dissemination of enriched knowledge in the space domain through its collaboration with institutions, start-ups, and NGOs involved in STEM activities. Out of 28 organisations selected to be a part of this initiative, Excel Public School is the only K-12 institution to be awarded this honour. Our Space Science and Astronomy Centre has been a pulsating place, with various events and programmes

conducted regularly for our students, parents, and general public.

Recently, we had the honour of collaborating with the Indian Institute of Astrophysics and COSMOS Mysore, to conduct a tethered helium balloon experiment. A high-altitude balloon was used to determine atmospheric conditions using sensors and radio transmissions.

Human Flight Expo was a series of competitions and events conducted by ISRO in July 2022 - at The Jawaharlal Nehru Planetarium in Bangalore, for students from grades 1 to 12. Excel Public School was selected from among 2000 institutions, to participate in this prestigious series of events. C B Swarna of Class 10, Lakshmi Hebbale Ram of Class 9, and Chinmay J of Class 7 won the first position in Sailplane Aeromodelling Competition, conducted as a part of this programme.



Kanva Udupa and Akash Savanur of Class 12 won the First Prize in the Quiz Competition and Vivek H P of Class 12 and Sohani M of Class 11 won the third prize in the inter-collegiate Astronomy Model-Making and Quiz Competition organised by Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam Science Foundation and Astronomy Club of Vidyavardhaka College of Engineering.



Excel Public School, has set up a Centre of Excellence for IoT (Internet of Things), AI, and Robotics, in collaboration with Factory Mind, a Norwegian company, to build a strong team of young leaders with extensive knowledge of future technologies. We have developed Tinkernest kits in the IoT Lab which consist of basic electronic kits that are used by all students in Classes 6 to 8. In addition to Arduino programming modules, our students also utilise Robotics Modules. IoT sensors are being used for R&D in this lab to create new products that align with our curriculum. This remarkable facility will give our students the much needed tech-advantage in the 4.0 world.

Our Innovation Centre and Atal Tinkering Lab have been giving our students unmatched experience and exposure to hands-on learning. We have been ranked among the top 25 out of the 12000 ATLs nationwide. The ATL Marathon is Atal Innovation Mission's flagship innovation challenge, where schools identify community problems of their choice and develop innovative solutions in the form of working prototypes. We had 21 teams selected among the top 350 teams from across 7000+ innovations for ATL Marathon-2022. This is the highest number of teams selected from any individual institution. The selected teams are currently undergoing internship opportunities with top companies and incubation centres of India. We have 60 teams preparing to participate in the current year's ATL Marathon.

Additionally, to strengthen the footprint of ATLs and to facilitate the performance of all ATLs to match with all other higher-performing ATLs, a collaboration of AIM, NITI Ayog and Excel Public School has started a pilot project known as ATL Cluster. We thank the authorities of the Atal Innovation Mission and the NITI Ayog for selecting Excel Public School to pioneer this ambitious initiative. As an initiative to make Mysore an exciting innovation ecosystem, EPS has laid a comprehensive plan to guide the ATLs in and around the district.

Excel Public School was invited to be a part of the prestigious event-DIDAC India, which is Asia's largest and the country's only educational fair. We presented our innovation in an exhibition planned for student innovator teams

for the AIM ecosystem. Aryan Kini of Class 8 received a significant opportunity of presenting a model on a Vertical Axis Wind Turbine at the event. Aryan's model was one of the twelve models chosen from the ATL labs across the country.

Tanish Tejaswi and Bhuvan P M of Class 9 won the first prize for presenting their innovative solutions for a Carbon Neutral Campus Competition during the International Conclave on Globalising Indian Thoughts at the Indian Institute of Management, Calicut.





Tanish Tejaswi is one among the recipients of the INSPIRE MANAK Award, instituted by the Department of Science & Technology (DST), Government of India, for the year 2022-23, for his project Smart Segregator, an automated system that can separate dry and moist waste without human assistance. He has won a cash prize of $\ref{thm:properties}$ 10,000/-. He has been selected to participate in the next level of this competition.

In the same competition, Sainirnay Sanjeev of Class 8 received the INSPIRE MANAK for 2021 in recognition of his Smart Animal Food Dispenser. Sainirnay received a stipend of $\stackrel{?}{=}$ 10,000/- to develop his project further.



Maker Mela is the premier event for grassroot innovations in India. C B Swarna of Class 10 was selected to represent her innovation at Maker's Mela in Mumbai for her project – Any Time Education. EPS was one among the eight schools selected across the country to be a part of this prestigious event.



With an objective to inspire, challenge, and empower students to become next-generation entrepreneurs Excel Public School started the Excel Young Entrepreneur programme in 2020. This programme is designed to hone 21st-century skills of researching, problem-solving, planning, critical thinking, and collaboration among the budding entrepreneurs, and is open to the students of Class 8-12. The participants learn various aspects of entrepreneurship and are provided the opportunity to pitch their idea in front of a jury, get feedback, and make course corrections. Selected teams then enter the incubation phase through the NEST (Nurturing Entrepreneurship among Students and Teachers). The Pitch-Fest of the current academic year will be held in April 2023.

Tanish Tejaswi of Class 9 has been ranked 3rd in the Indian Entrepreneurship Olympiad conducted by IIT Guwahati. With this rank, Tanish has advanced to the next level of the programme known as 'Pitching Battle' where the top 20 students from across India will present their innovative ideas to the industry leaders and have a chance to

We currently have 100 Cadets in the Jr. Wing and 50 Cadets in Sr. Wing. I am happy and proud to say that within a short span of its existence, the NCC Jr. wing of EPS has made history by being chosen as the Second Best Unit in the Directorate of Karnataka and Goa. Sergeant Samanvitha C B was

accorded the Chief Minister's Commendation, Sergeant Savi Kiran Holla and Sergeant Deeksha V received the Deputy Director General's Commendation in the recently held Awards Ceremony. Our Cadets have also participated in the All India Thal Sainik Camp, All India G. V. In addition to the above mentioned special programmes, I would also like to complement the teachers and students who are involved in various other scholastic and co-scholastic programmes in the school, such as the EPS Eco-Club, Astronomy Club, the Excellerate Club, the EPS Readers' and Writers' Club, the Robotics Club, the EPS Cultural Canvas and the Social Outreach Club for taking up various programmes and initiatives, all through the academic year, to promote and foster the diverse skills and talents of our students.











I also appreciate and compliment the teachers and students who are actively involved in the Awakened Citizen Programme (ACP), an initiative of the Ramakrishna Mission, to enable our youngsters to develop faith in themselves, discover values and make responsible choices. On this occasion, I congratulate Ms. Vanishree for being chosen as the 'Teacher Value Ambassador, South Zone', and for successfully organising the first ever Inter-School Value Conference, involving around hundred students and ten teachers from various schools of Mysore. The Inter-Class Value Conferences that are being organised for the students of Classes 6 to 10 of Excel Public School, I am sure, will make notable changes in the way our students look at themselves and the society they live in.

COMPETITIONS

EPS encourages our students' participation in various competitive exams conducted by reputed educational institutions and organisations. This year too, the school prides itself on the exemplary performance of our students in the National Olympiad Exams, the ASSET exams, the Silver Zone Olympiad, National Astronomy and Science Olympiad, to name a few. In these competitions, our students secured top positions at the District, State and National levels.

Under Literary and Cultural Competitions, we conducted a total of 66 events in 5 categories. These competitions provided our students, with opportunities to exhibit their talents in the chosen area and inspired a healthy spirit of competition. We organised 230 Sports and Games events as part of the Sports Days, involving students from Class 3 to Class 12. I appreciate the efforts taken by the CCA Committee and the Physical Education Department for successfully organising these competitions.

Field trips are also part of the extended learning activities. It is worth mentioning the 13 field trips across classes catering to learning opportunities in areas like Life sciences, Mathematics, English, Home Science and Languages. Students from Classes 3 to 12 went for on-site visits that included museums, historical places, agricultural farms, factories and industrial units.

Extended learning activities and inter-disciplinary projects were conducted throughout the year with the help and support of the K-12 division of Excelsoft. There were 67 class wise learning events and inter-disciplinary programmes conducted for Classes 3 to 10, kindling scientific temper and spirit of enquiry among the students. These activity-based learning sessions helped our students gain a deeper understanding in various subjects, ranging from material sciences to space science and geographical phenomena to archaeological excavations.
