**1. Reopening Dates:** The reopening dates for various classes remain unchanged.

- Classes 3 to 12 : 2<sup>nd</sup> June (Monday)
- Classes UKG, 1 and 2 : 4<sup>th</sup> June (Wednesday)
- Classes Pre-School and LKG : 5<sup>th</sup> June (Thursday)

We request you to ensure your child's presence on the first day itself. **Late reporting of students after the vacation will not be appreciated**, and, therefore, thoroughly discouraged.

2. **New Handbook:** Kindly go through the new School Handbook for updates and changes. Please ensure strict adherence to the guidelines and instructions outlined in it.
3. **Books and Uniform:** Parents who have not yet collected textbooks, uniforms, or other materials must do so on **28<sup>th</sup>/29<sup>th</sup> May**. There will be **no distribution** of these items on the reopening day. Students who have not collected these materials will not be allowed to attend classes on the day of their reporting.
4. **School Transport:** The final list of students availing school transport will be shared by **30<sup>th</sup> May 2025 through a notification in the School App**. Only those students whose names appear on the list will be permitted to board the buses on the first day of school.
5. **COVID Advisory:** Although the situation remains under control, we continue to prioritise the health and safety of our students and staff. Students showing symptoms of fever, cold, cough, or general illness are advised to **wear a mask, carry sanitizer and personal water bottle, and maintain good hygiene practices** at all times. Students with more intense symptoms are **strongly advised to remain at home** until they have fully recovered.
6. **Lunch Facility:** Parents who wish to avail the school lunch facility, but yet to confirm the same, are requested to do so **on or before 30th May**.
