**Subject:** Fostering Core Values of EPS – The 'RICER' Framework

At EPS, we have always believed that education is not just about academic success, but about nurturing individuals who embody strong values and character. In line with this vision, we are proud to formally adopt a set of core values under the acronym 'RICER' - a guiding framework that we hope will shape our students into responsible, compassionate, and future-ready citizens of the world. These values resonate deeply with our school's vision: 'empowering young minds towards a progressive and humane society'.

The five core values that form the foundation of **character education at EPS**, along with a brief definition of each, are as follows:

# 1. RESPECT

Respect is recognizing the worth of oneself and every other individual and treating them with kindness, valuing their differences, and listening to them with empathy.

## 2. INTEGRITY

Integrity is being honest and doing what is right, even when no one is watching, and staying true to your values with courage, confidence, and consistency.

## 3. COURAGE

Courage is standing up for what is legally, morally, and ethically right, facing challenges with strength, and listening with humility, even when it's hard.

## 4. EMPATHY

Empathy is understanding how someone else feels, seeing things from their point of view, and being kind and caring when they need support.

## 5. RESPONSIBILITY

Responsibility is taking ownership of your actions and choices, learning from their consequences, and doing your part to make your home, school, society, and nation a better place.



These values will be woven into every aspect of school life - our culture, classrooms, activities, and interactions - not just as ideals, but as lived and shared experiences. However, we know that the strongest foundation for character is built when **home and school work together**. This is where your role as parents becomes truly invaluable. Robert John Meehan says, "Education requires a collective effort: the teacher, the student, the parents and the community". We invite our parent community to partner with us in nurturing these values by:

- **Modelling them in daily life** Children watch and learn from what we do.
- **Initiating conversations** Create space to reflect on these values through real-life situations.
