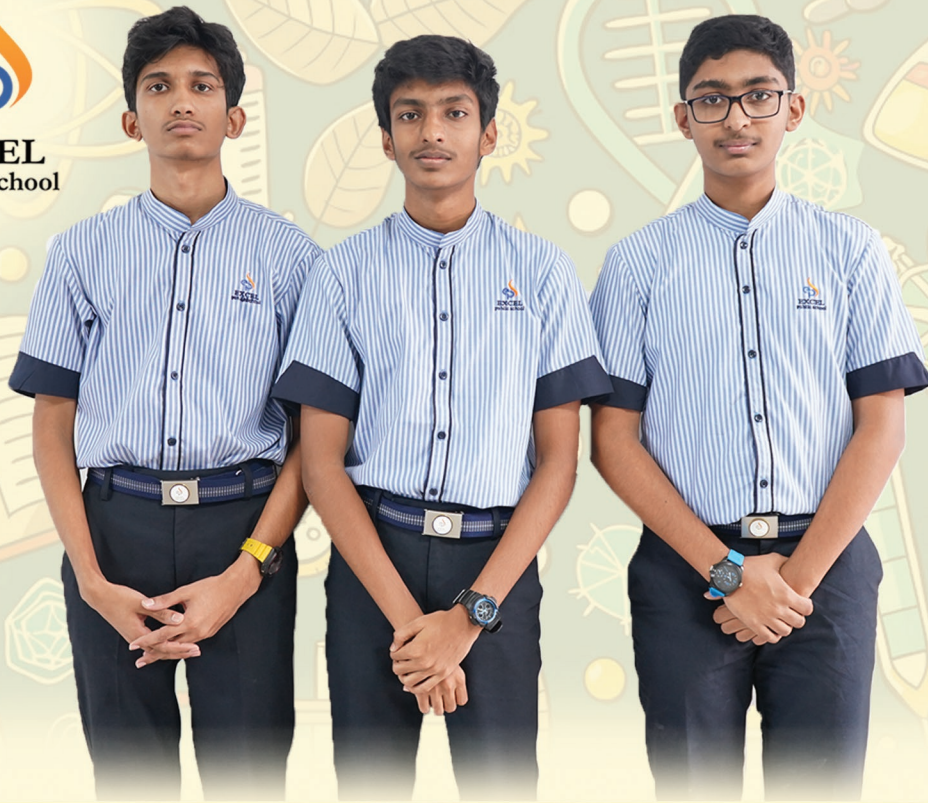




Research Beyond the Classroom
