Greetings from Excel Public School!

We would like to inform you that 15th August 2026 will be a working day for students of Classes 3 to 12, in observance of the 80th Independence Day Celebrations at school. Attendance is compulsory for all students. The details are as follows:

- Reporting Time : 7:45 a.m.
- Flag Hoisting : 8:15 a.m.
- Venue : Amphitheatre

Students availing the school transport are requested to report to their respective bus boarding points one hour earlier than the regular schedule. The return trip from the school will commence at 12:30 p.m.

Students who come by private vehicles should reach school by 7:45 a.m. All the students are requested to attend the programme in their regular school uniform.

The flag hoisting will be followed by the formal function and Independence Day Procession. As part of the Freedom March, students of Classes 3 to 5 may come dressed as national leaders, freedom fighters or in attire that represents the rich cultural diversity of India, thereby adding colour and significance to the celebration. Students are also requested to carry National Flag for the Freedom March (Plastic and paper flags are strictly prohibited.)

To nurture the spirit of sharing and togetherness, a class-wise Community Feast will be organised. Parents are requested to send homemade traditional snacks in slightly larger quantities so that they may be shared among classmates. Students should also carry a steel plate, steel tumbler, steel spoon and napkin.
